I appreciated the opportunity to meet with you on November 24, 1964 to discuss the status of the Shelter Program in the City of Boston.

As indicated at that time, although the locating, licensing and marking phases of the Shelter Program have progressed satisfactorily, the stocking of shelters has not moved as expected. In fact, no stocking has been accomplished since August 11, 1964.

The many demands on your office, particularly at this time, are fully appreciated. However, it appears that unless assistance along the lines we discussed at our meeting is made available to the Boston Civil Defense organization, the Program will remain at a standstill.

Your efforts in this respect will be greatly appreciated.
