REQUISITIONS FOR RESERVE PERSONNEL TOP 200

Requisitions for more than 200 military reserve officers to serve on local and Sector Civil Defense staffs have been processed. With but few exceptions, requests for Standby Reservists all have originated from within Area 3.

More than 100,000 Reservists are available and many of the local communities which voice difficulties in manning their staffs should seek aid from this manpower stockpile.
